

ORDINANCE NO. 18

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSUMPTION OF MALT BEVERAGES AND UNFORTIFIED WINE UPON ALL PROPERTY AND PREMISES OWNED OR OCCUPIED BY THE COUNTY OF CASWELL.

BE IT ORDAINED pursuant to the authority of North Carolina General Statute 18B-300 by the Board of County Commissioners of Caswell County:

Section 1 DECLARATION OF POLICY

It is the policy of this County to prohibit, forbid and restrict the consumption of malt beverages and unfortified wine upon any and all property and premises owned or occupied by the County of Caswell.

Section 2 AUTHORITY

The Board of County Commissioners of Caswell County is authorized to adopt an ordinance regulating the consumption of malt beverages and unfortified wine on property or premises owned or occupied by said County under the provisions of North Carolina General Statute 18B-300.

Section 3 PROHIBITED ACTS

All and any consumption of malt beverages and unfortified wine upon property or premises owned or occupied by the County of Caswell is hereby prohibited, forbidden and restricted.

Section 4 SUPPLEMENTAL PURPOSE

This ordinance, as adopted, is in addition to the provisions and terms of Chapter 18B and Article 2C of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes of North Carolina and the rules and regulations of the North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission.

Section 5 PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

Any person violating the terms, provisions and conditions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable upon conviction by a fine and or imprisonment as provided by North Carolina General Statute 14-4.

Section 6 REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

All ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 7 EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption.
