

ORDINANCE NO. 20

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR BOATS ON
LAKE HYCO

1. PROHIBITION OF JET-PROPELLED VESSELS: It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or cause to be operated on the waters of Lake Hyco any vessel powered by a jet engine or any jet propulsion device. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not less than \$100.00 and prohibited from going upon the waters of Lake Hyco for a period of one (1) year from the date of being found guilty of the violation.
2. MUFFLING DEVICES - MOTOR BOATS: The exhaust of every internal combustion engine used on any motor boat operating on the waters of Lake Hyco shall be effectively muffled by equipment so constructed and used to muffle the noise of the exhaust in a reasonable and efficient manner. The use of cut-outs and straight pipes is prohibited except as may be exempted by the Person-Caswell Lake Authority for regattas and boat races duly approved by said board.
3. LIMITATION ON SPEED OF MOTOR BOATS: It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motorized vessel on the waters of Lake Hyco at a speed in excess of 50 m.p.h. It is further prohibited that no person shall operate a motorized vessel on the waters of Lake Hyco at a speed or in a manner that is reckless or negligent as relates to the then existing water, traffic, or passageway width conditions so as to endanger the life, limb or property of any person. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and be prohibited from going upon the waters of Lake Hyco for a period of one (1) year following the date of being found guilty of said offense.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall be effective on and after the 21st day of November, 1983. Unanimously adopted, pursuant to the authority of General Statute 153A-121, this the 21st day of November, 1983, by the Caswell County Board of Commissioners at its regular meeting in the Caswell County Courthouse, Yanceyville, North Carolina.
