CALL MEETING TO ORDER

GENERAL UPDATES FROM LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

TOWN OF MILTON

Mayor Daniel-Upchurch gave the following updates:

- Milton has moved Town Hall meetings to the Presbyterian Church.
- Milton continues to seek grants for the improvement of the water and sewer system.
- They acquired a park space and a space for parking.
- They were accepted into the 2024 Rural Capacity Forum and are hoping to be eble to change the focus to infrastructure.

TOWN OF YANCEYVILLE

Mayor Foster then gave the following updates:

- First Friday on June 7th. Matt Boswell will be in Concert and there will be food for purchase. The event will begin at 7 pm.
- Fireworks show is scheduled for June 28, 2024, and food trucks will be on site.

- Dillard revitalization project is progressing. Pre-construction meeting will be on May 23, 2024. Water line construction to begin and that will need to be done before the completion date is determined.
- Eckerd Project is almost ready to place boys in the building. Open house was last week. The facility is all inclusive: school, meals, and sleep. This project will bring 53 jobs to the county.
- About to start infrastructure work on the sewer system.
- Community Shred Day May 17th at the Pavilion 10:30 am to 6:30 pm.

CASWELL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

County Manager Meszaros gave the following updates:

- Rest stop area has sewer troubles in Pelham for the County.
- Tax Director said the reevaluation notices should start to come out tomorrow through Saturday. The Evaluation is estimated at 38%.
- Recycle-Electronics and paper goods can be taken to the shred event on May 17, 2024.
- Co-Square is open, but not the front of the building. Most of the tenants are back inside.
- The Commissioners are working on the budget, but it has been a challenge.
- Broadband: Almost finish with the first phase of the GREAT Grant. CAB grant should begin soon. Bid is open until end of June. NCDIT will answer your questions. RDOF is finished, and GREAT grant is behind since Zitel pulled out. CAB is just beginning and other programs to follow.
