Why Does Daylight Savings Time Exist?

According to the "historians" daylight savings time was originally implemented during WWI to help conserve fuel and power in the US. Time zones in the US began in the late 1800's to help railroad companies coordinate a long time and to reduce the likelihood of trains crashing due to the difference in how time was kept. Before this, there were over 144 local times zones in North America.

The government didn't alter time zones until 1918, with the passage of the Standard Time Act of 1918. At that time, the Interstate Commerce Commission was put in charge of time zones.

The idea came during WWI and it was thought by shifting time we would get more daylight hours & would reduce the need for lighting, After the war's conclusion, daylight savings time was abolished nationally, with some states continuing the practice.

Don't forget to fall back an hour on Sunday November o3 and enjoy an extra hour of sleep. But don't be late for church.
